Our independent documentary film follows overland expeditions that travel Europe and Morocco in 4x4 vehicles and live out of their car. Many of them have given up their entire life in Europe, sold their accomodation, gave up jobs and cancelled careers.

While travelling they are looking for adventure and for an alternative live style to flee a world of crisis and uncertainty. But what is their mission? Do they need a mission at all?

We want to follow some of the travellers tracks through the desert and into Atlas Mountains, where driving and living becomes a challenge. We portray the beauties of the country, the sky, the desert, gravel roads and dunes that attract adventurers and tourists alike.

But what are travellers bringing to Morocco? Are they interested in Moroccan culture? Will they encounter miracles and listen to one thousand and one marvellous stories each night?

Peter Haas and Silvia Holzinger are independent filmmakers. Their films have been presented mainly on film festivals or low-budget TV channels, such as PLANET. This project is a NO-BUDGET-FILM that might evolve into a YouTube video for our homepage. Although we have created documentary films in the past, we did not film for more than 10 years. Our travel will mainly be holidays and adventure for ourselves, if permitted we will film 10-14 days during the journey. We do not ask for production support. We do not apply for funding.
